# The NRRU International Graduate Scholarship (NRRU-IGS)

## **Eligibility:**

If all the below statements describe you and your current situation, you can apply for this scholarship:

- 1. I hold one of the following nationalities: Bruneian, Burmese, Indonesian, Filipino, Malaysian, Laotian, Singaporean, Vietnamese, Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Australian, New Zealander or Indian.
- 2. I completed bachelor degree, or equivalent, with a minimum GPA of 2.80 out of a scale of 4.00 (70%). GPAs that do not meet the required minimum may be considered under exceptional circumstances.
- 3. I have an educational background and/or relevant work experience that is relevant to the master I intend to study.
- 4. I am able to communicate in English efficiently.
- 5. I will be able to study all courses in Thai language.

- 3. A certified copy of Passport or ID card
- 4. A certified copy of transcript/academic record
- 5. A certified copy of bachelor's degree, or equivalent, completion certificate
- 6. Two letters of reference from teachers/advisers
- 7. A certified copy of certificate of proficiency in English (if any)
- 8. Essay written in either **English** or **Thai** on the topic, 'Benefits of studying in **Thailand to myself and my country**'. Essay should be approximately 500 words in length.

Applicants can choose one of the following degrees:

- 1. Master of Public Health Program in Community Health Development
- 2. Master of Education Program in Curriculum and Instruction

#### **Selection Procedure:**

The NRRU International Scholarship Scheme 2016 committee will draw up a short list of candidates on the basis of outstanding academic record and Thai language competency. The short-listed candidates will be interviewed, via telephone/Skype/Line etc., and considered on the basis of intention, attitude, extra-curricular activities, international perception and adaptability to a new country.

#### **Benefits and Conditions:**

- 1. Successful candidates will be exempt from tuition fees for 4 semesters (2 academic years) or 4 semesters and 2 summer sessions (2 academic years) depending on the degree undertaken.
- 2. Successful candidates are required to pay a registration fee of 2,000 Baht.
- 3. Successful candidates are required to pay a damage warranty fee of 1,000 Baht.
- 4. Please note that the scholarship may be suspended or terminated if the scholars have not made satisfactory progress in the first semester. Failure in two or more courses in a semester will automatically result in the termination of the scholarship.
- 5. During the scholarship period, any employment of the scholars must be approved by the Director of the International Affairs Office.
- 6. The scholars under NRRU-IGS can apply for other scholarships, if the other scholarships allow them to do so.
